- 2. What does it mean as Christians to have the righteousness of faith, and not of works?
- 3. What doctrinal revelation is the work of God?
- 4. What is the specific doctrine upon which the church stands or falls?
- 5. Discuss how Paul's statement that God will "reveal that also to you" ties in with Luther's explanation of the third article of the creed in the small catechism: "I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to Him; but the Holy Ghost has called me by the Gospel"?
- 6. Do these verses contain law, gospel, or both?
